This presents to you a challenge and a great opportunity to expand your horizons. Organisations such as maritime management school of IMU, Institute of Chartered Shipbrokers, Narottam Morarjee Institute of Shipping, NIA etc. can help you. The opportunities are endless.
- 3. Please remember, you will never automatically get time for learning and training. Something else, apparently more important will come and fill in your time-space. Thus, remember for learning and development you have to "make time" by redesigning your daily routine.... say as my Guru ji, used to say buy one more watch see, now you have 48 hours!
- 4. Listen to podcasts and videos posted by organisations and firms such as LR, DNV, Wartsila and there are many more. You can download them in your YouTube offline library and listen to them at your leisure. My favourite place and time for this "during air travel".
- 5. Finally, each one of us is a teacher as well as learner. What you can teach your junior the job through your action performance, he or she will never learn in a class room or on a simulator. Let this be the in vour conscience and consciousness minds that we learn more through sharing. And, then the knowledge chain continues.
